Decatur Dental Services will be adding extra measures to the normal universal precautions to ensure the health and safety of our patients and staff. We will continue to screen all patients before scheduling and again the day of the appointment.

These additional practices will also be implemented-

- 1) Patients will wait in their cars until we are ready for you.
- 2) Upon entry you will be offered hand sanitizer and we may take your temperature.
- 3) We ask that parents, sibling(s), companions please wait in their car.
- 4) Continue social distancing measures in every way possible.
- 5) Staff may be wearing face shields and medical gowns.
- 6) ALL touch points will be disinfected continuously throughout the day.
