► Root Canal Treatment

By using advances in technology, materials and instrumentation, Dr. Mudassar makes this previously feared procedure not only tolerable, but also often quite comfortable. No longer will you need to schedule another appointment with an out-of-town specialist - it can all be done in our office!

Root canal treatments are commonly completed in just one visit. Patients are usually pleasantly surprised when they are finished, astonished at how painless it was.

► Tooth Extractions

If a tooth is damaged or decayed irreparably, or if a root canal cannot save a tooth, we may recommend a simple extraction. If you do need to have a tooth extracted, we will perform the removal with care and gentleness and we can replace it with a variety of restorations including implants.

► Wisdom Teeth Extraction

While some people's wisdom teeth – the third and final set of molars that most people get in their late teens or early twenties– sometimes do not cause trouble, they are usually impacted or misaligned and require removal. If they are not removed, they can cause pain and crowding. Removal is easier for younger people, when the roots are not yet fully developed so we recommend that you have your wisdom teeth evaluated as soon as they come in.
