Dental Sealants

A sealant is a plastic material that is usually applied to the chewing surfaces of the back teeth-premolars and molars. This plastic resin bonds into the depressions and grooves (pits and fissures) of the chewing surfaces of back teeth. The sealant acts as a barrier, protecting enamel from plaque and acids.

How are sealants placed?

- The teeth that will be sealed are cleaned.
- The chewing surfaces are roughened with an acid solution to help the sealant adhere to the tooth.
- The sealant is "painted" onto the tooth enamel.
- A special light is used to help the sealant harden.





A sealant can last as long as 5 to 10 years. Sealants should be checked at your regular dental appointments and can be reapplied if they are no longer in place.



FALL FOR SMILES FACTS

Remember to brush your teeth twice a day for two minutes, and floss at least once, too

Visit your dentist for a checkup every 6 months

Make healthy food choices and pick snacks that are nutritious

Always avoid tobacco products
