We offer 2 ways to get whiter teeth. The first procedure is take home whitening. We take molds of your teeth and fabricate custom trays. You then use the bleaching material everyday for 2 weeks. The other method is the Sapphire Whitening System. This is where we apply the bleaching material to your teeth in the office. You will have whiter teeth in 1 hour!! We like the Sapphire System because it is specially formulated to prevent sensitivity. Custom trays and bleaching materials are included with this treatment for future use. Your new shade using either method should last about 3 years. If you drink coffee, tea, or red wine, you may have to "touch-up" your shade more often. If you are interested in having whiter teeth, please give us a call!!
