

Do you need antibiotics before your dental visit?---Rules have changed. You may not need them anymore.

NEED THEM IF:

- Any artificial heart valves
- History of infective endocarditis
- Total Joint replacement with other medically compromising issues
- discuss with Dr. Knott or your orthopedic and bring letter recommending if they advise it
- Serious congenital (born with it) heart condition—discuss with Dr. Knott

TOTAL JOINT REPLACEMENT AND OTHERWISE HEALTHY

- Mitral valve prolapse
- Rheumatic heart disease
- Pace Maker or Surgical stents
- Longer than 2 years after total joint replacement and healthy
