

>>Post-op Care Instructions



Veneers

- > Anesthetic is usually used for veneer preparations. Your lips and tongue could be numb for several hours after your appointment. It is recommended that you avoid chewing until the numbness has worn off completely to avoid injury.
- > Sensitivity to hot, cold, and pressure is normal after your appointment. The injection site may also be sore. Over the counter pain medications should handle any discomfort.
- > As dental veneers are bonded to the tooth, there is some chance that the bonding agent may fail, resulting in the veneer "popping" off the tooth. If this happens, bring the veneer with you to our office. We may be able to re-bond it to your tooth.
- > If you notice any dark staining at the gum line; experience hot, cold, or bite sensitivity, or any other unexplained persistent sensitivity, please call our office for an exam.
