We are open!!

We are happy to report our office is open from 8am-5pm Monday through Friday. We will be closed daily from 12pm to 1pm for lunch. Only patients who have scheduled appointments will be able to enter the office. Most other business can be handled over the phonejust give us a call as we are here to help you!

If you have a scheduled appointment in the month of June, you will be receiving a phone call from one of our PCCs to assist you with your appointment. Since our office hours have been temporarily reduced, some appointments will need to be rescheduled.

You are all important to us and we are committed to helping you get back to your regular dental care routine as soon as possible.

Infection control has always been a top priority in our practice and you may have seen this during your visits to our office. We want to tell you about the additional infection control measures and safety protocols we are taking when you come for your appointments.

For example:

- You will notice all of our staff will be wearing additional PPE (personal protective equipment).
- Everyone that enters the office is screened, including staff, every day.
- We will communicate with you before your scheduled appointments to ask some screening questions. You will be asked these questions again when you arrive for your appointment.
- We have closed our waiting room for the time being and only one patient enters the office at a time. All surfaces are disinfected between patients.
- Sneeze guards have been installed at the front desk.
- Temporary barriers have been installed on each treatment room door, while custom doors are being fabricated off site.

- HEPA and UV air filters have been placed in each treatment room and throughout the office.
- Treatment rooms are being used on an alternating basis. No treatment is being performed in a room that was just occupied by another patient.
- Each treatment room is fogged with a disinfectant periodically throughout the day. This enables us to sanitize even hard to reach areas.
- UVC sterilization is performed in each operatory after staff leave for the day.
- We have streamlined the check out process to make your visit as touch free as possible for you and our staff and to limit your time in the office.
